If the proposed ordinance is not signed or vetoed by the Parish President within Twelve (12) hours after receipt it shall be considered adopted. AN ORDINANCE TO **RESCIND ORDINANCE SBPC #2062-05-18**, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21, VEHICLES FOR HIRE, TO CREATE ARTICLE III, TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES (TNC) OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That **Ordinance SBPC #2062-05-18**, amending Chapter 21, Vehicles for Hire, to create Article III, Transportation Network Companies (TNC) of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinance is hereby rescinded therefore making it null and void.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto this ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.
