22-2-4. Definitions.

Grocery store (seven thousand five hundred (7,500) square feet <u>or greater</u> to less than thirty thousand (30,000) square feet): A retail establishment offering a wide variety of packaged and non-packaged food items, household merchandise, and health and personal care items. A grocery store shall offer fresh meat and produce options as a part of its operations.

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER FOR THE BUREAU OF ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION.

- **SECTION 1.** The St. Bernard Parish Council hereby appoints XXXXXXX as Hearing Officer of the Bureau of Administrative Adjudication pursuant to Chapter 2.5, Section 2.5-3 of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances.

If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.
