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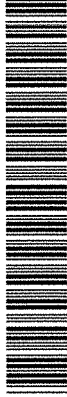

AMENDMENT NO. 3
TO AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
OWNER AND ENGINEER
FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES

This is an Amendment No. 3 attached to and made part of the Agreement dated November 9, 2015, between St. Bernard Parish (OWNER) and Shread-Kuyrkendall & Associates, Inc. (“Engineer”) for professional services related to the Water Booster Station at the Reggio Water Tower (“The Project”).

The November 9, 2015 Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

1. Under Exhibit A, 1.0 Engineer Services, add Tasks 9 and 10 as follows:

Task 9 – Environmental Review Record

Task 9.1 Environmental Review Record Preparation

An ERR will be prepared based upon the requirements of OCD’s 2016 LCDBG Grantee Handbook and will include the following:

- Environmental Assessment Signature Form (Exhibit A-24 of handbook)
- Completed Environmental Assessment Checklist (Exhibit A-25 of handbook)
- Documentation of compliance with other federal laws; completion of Worksheet for Preparing 24 CFR 58.5 Statutory Checklist (Exhibit A-21 of handbook)
- Completion of Statutory Checklist (Exhibit A-22 of handbook)
- Documentation of Compliance with CFR Part 58.6 (Exhibit A-18 of handbook)
- A detailed project description of the project including location and whether or not the ERR is site specific.
- A map of the entire jurisdiction showing the location of the project area with clear boundaries indicated and specific activities in relation to streets or other landmarks.
- A floodplain map delineating the target area
- A wetlands map delineating the target area.

Previous information obtained through FEMA contact of various federal and state resource agencies will be utilized by the Engineer to complete the ERR. Only contact of any additional agencies not included in the original solicitation by FEMA will be provided by the Engineer. The eight (8) step process will be completed if the project’s presence in the floodplain or wetland area requires it. Any wetland or coastal use permitting that may be required for the project will be performed under Task 4.

Task 9.2 – Preparation of Draft ERR

A draft ERR shall be prepared for review by the Owner. Upon receipt of comments the ERR shall be revised and submitted for OCD approval.

Task 9.3 – Coordination of Publication and Release of Funds

The Engineer will coordinate the production and release of the following:

- Publication and Distribution of Combined Notice of Finding of No Significant Impact and Intent to Release Funds (Exhibit A-26 of Handbook) and Notice of Finding No Significant Impact Distribution List (Exhibit A-27 of Handbook)
- Request for Release of Funds and Certification (Exhibit A-2 of Handbook)

It is anticipated both Owner and OCD will provide the publication and distribution of these notices. The Engineer will assist with the preparation of the notices and coordination of their release.

Task 10 – Amoeba Sampling Activities

Task 10.1 – Review of DHH Sampling Activities

Engineer's staff will be notified of DHH sampling events for Amoeba in the St. Bernard Parish water distribution system. Two staff will accompany DHH staff to various sampling locations and observe their sampling protocol and activities. If more than two crews are utilized by DHH, then Owner's staff will accompany and observe the activities of those crews. Observations shall be summarized under Task 10.3 below.

Task 10.2 – Acquisition of Duplicate Samples

Engineer's staff will obtain duplicate samples for each DHH sampling location on the same day DHH obtains their samples as coordination allows. Nine samples will be obtained at various locations throughout the Parish and analyzed for *Naegleria fowleri*. Samples will be obtained utilizing two of Engineer's staff and two of the Owner's staff under direction of the Engineer. The locations shall match the locations selected by DHH. Nine samples will be performed based upon DHH previous sampling activities. If additional samples are required, an additional cost per sample will be accessed. All samples will be transferred under Chain-of-Custody to BCS Laboratories for analysis. The samples will be analyzed for *Naegleria fowleri* via culture and polymerase chain reaction (PCR) methods identified by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and BCS SOP A-1.

Task 10.3 – Summary Memorandum

Upon completion of Task 10.1 and 10.2 a draft technical memorandum will be provided that summarizes the results of these activities. The memorandum will report the results of the sampling event and discuss any concerns observed during the Engineer and DHH sampling activities.

2. Under Exhibit A, 3.0 Time Period For Performance, add the following:

Tasks 9.1 and 9.2 shall be completed within twelve (12) weeks of notice to proceed. Task 9.3 shall be initiated upon approval of Finding of No Significant Impact. Task 10 sampling activities shall be performed upon notification from DHH and the Owner that a sampling event is to be performed by DHH. One week notification should be provided to properly coordinate activities.

3. Under Exhibit A, 4.0 Method of Payment, add the following:

Task 9 services described above will be provided for a lump sum fee of \$21,500. Task 10 services described above will be provided for a lump sum fee of \$10,000 per sampling event. If additional samples are required during each sampling event an additional fee of \$750 per sample will be charged.
