AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10 FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION; ARTICLE I IN GENERAL; SECTION 10-8 OPERATION AND STAFFING OF PARISH FIRE STATIONS OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That St. Bernard Parish Council does hereby amend as attached in "Exhibit A" Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-8 of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

Exhibit "A"

Chapter 10, Fire Protection and Prevention
Article I, In General
Section 10-8, Operation and Staffing of Parish Fire Stations

- (b) *Hours of operation.* Fire stations Nos. 1 through 12 plus squad one, including engines 1 through 12 and squad 1 and 2, shall be opened on a twenty-four hour day, seven (7) days per week basis staffed by professional firefighters.
- (c) *Staffing of fire department.* A minimum of one hundred and ten (110) employees shall be maintained to staff and operate the St. Bernard Parish Fire Department, and further, in order to keep stations open, administration shall hire additional employees on an overtime basis as needed to keep fire stations open in accordance with subsection (b) above.
- (d) *Exceptions.* Engine training out of its district, but still in service. Major emergencies, natural disasters, hazardous material incidents and/or refinery fires.
- (e) Fire stations Nos 4 and 9 do not exist at present.
