BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON TUESDAY, APRIL 21, 2015 AT SEVEN O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. Lewis, seconded by Mr. Gorbaty, it was moved to adopt the following emergency ordinance:

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SBPC #1638-04-15

AN ORDINANCE TO ORDER A 24 HOUR DEMOLITION NOTICE IN THE INTEREST OF PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY AT 2909 VOLPE AND 2920 PLAZA PENDING LEGAL CONSIDERATION THAT THE PROPERTIES ARE AN IMMINENT DANGER AS REPORTED BY ADMINISTRATION.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, The Governing Authority of St. Bernard Parish believes it to be in the best interest of the citizens of St. Bernard Parish and St. Bernard Parish Government to demolish the pools located on 2909 Volpe and 2920 Plaza upon determination that these structures pose a danger to the health and safety of the citizens of St. Bernard Parish.

SECTION 1. The Parish Council hereby ordains and decrees, in the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of St. Bernard Parish, if the pools located on 2909 Volpe and 2920 Plaza are deemed in dangerous and dilapidated condition, by the administration, such pools shall be immediately demolished.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. If the proposed ordinance is not signed or vetoed by the Parish President within Twelve (12) hours after receipt it shall be considered adopted. As an emergency ordinance the provisions shall remain valid for a time period of sixty (60) days.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:




