EXTRACT OF THE OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE PARISH OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT AN EMERGENCY MEETING HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON WEDNESDAY, JULY 15, 2015 AT NINE FIFTEEN A.M.

On motion of Mr. Montelongo, seconded by Mr. Lewis, it was moved to adopt the following ordinance:

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SBPC #1663-07-15

Summary No. 3265

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO PRESERVE PROPERTY AND SAFETY OF ST. BERNARD PARISH DATA AND ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority of St. Bernard Parish believes it to be in the best interest of the citizens of St. Bernard Parish and St. Bernard Parish Government to preserve property and safety of St. Bernard parish data and electronic systems given current circumstances.

THE ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council, the Governing Authority, does hereby direct the Parish President to immediately take all steps necessary to restrict access and remote access to all St. Bernard Parish Government physical properties and electronic data systems from all Paratech owners, managers, personnel and/or affiliates or businesses owned by any of the above until such time as the Louisiana Attorney General's investigation is complete. This includes but it not limited to;

- a. retrieval of ID badges and restriction of building entry of the persons/entities numerated above
- b. direct St. Bernard Parish IT personnel to secure the system via required employee password changes and any other digital means available
- c. issue a full report of all steps taken under this ordinance to the parish council within 24 hours of the effective of this ordinance

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. If the proposed ordinance is not signed or vetoed by the Parish President within Twelve (12) hours after receipt it shall be considered adopted. As an emergency ordinance the provisions shall remain valid for a time period of sixty (60) days.

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SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.






Dear Madam Clerk:
