BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2016 AT THREE O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. Lewis, seconded by Mr. Luna, it was moved to **adopt** the following ordinance:

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SBPC #1730-02-16

Summary No. 3351

Introduced by: Councilmember Lewis on 2/18/16

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING SCOTT M. SMITH AS THE HEARING OFFICER FOR THE BUREAU OF ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish Council, the governing authority for St. Bernard Parish, deems it to be an emergency affecting the health and public safety that a Hearing Officer for the Bureau of Administrative Adjudication be appointed in time to hear the Bureau of Administrative Adjudication hearings that are currently set for hearing.

SECTION 1. The St. Bernard Parish Council hereby appoints Scott M. Smith as Hearing Officer of the Bureau of Administrative Adjudication pursuant to Chapter 2.5, Section 2.5-3 of the St. Bernard Parish Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2. The compensation for Scott M. Smith shall be \$27,000.00 per year, pursuant to an independent contractor/professional services agreement. No other compensation or benefits shall be paid to Scott M. Smith for serving as Hearing Officer.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. If the proposed ordinance is not signed or vetoed by the Parish President within Twelve (12) hours after receipt it shall be considered adopted. As an emergency ordinance the provisions shall remain valid for a time period of sixty (60) days.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

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

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
