A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ST. BERNARD PORT, HARBOR AND TERMINAL DISTRICT'S APPLICATION FOR TIGER FUNDS FOR CHALMETTE SLIP DOCK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the St. Bernard Port, Harbor and Terminal District has submitted an application for TIGER funds for the Chalmette Slip Dock Improvements Projects; and,

WHEREAS, these dock improvements constitute a vital project for the region, notably impacting all of the primary goals of the TIGER program; and,

WHEREAS, improving transportation conditions, contributing to the economic competitiveness of the United States, fostering more livable communities, improving energy efficiency and increasing safety; and,

WHEREAS, projects of this kind are top priorities for the Parish as we build the infrastructure and capacity to attract new jobs and investments; and,

WHEREAS, this project would not only improve the safety and quality of life of the residents of St. Bernard, Louisiana but it will also create jobs in the region; and,
