### RESOLUTION SBPC #1170-05-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PARISH PRESIDENT AND THE COUNCIL CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN ST. BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT AND THE ST. BERNARD PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN REGARD TO LITTER PICKUP.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the St. Bernard Parish Government to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding in connection with litter pickup, and;

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish President David E. Peralta and Council Chairman Guy McInnis, is hereby authorized and directed to do, or cause to be done, all such acts and things and to execute and deliver or cause to be executed the litter pickup Memorandum of Understanding, in the name of and on behalf of St. Bernard Parish Government, as they may deem necessary or appropriate to carry out the intent of the foregoing resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Bernard Parish Council, the Governing Authority, does hereby authorize Parish President David E. Peralta and Council Chairman Guy McInnis to sign and to execute the Memorandum of Understanding regarding the St. Bernard Parish Sheriff's Department Litter Pickup Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Resolution, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion of this Resolution with the invalid portions omitted.
