On motion of Mr. Lauga, seconded by Mr. Montelongo, it was moved to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION SBPC #1289-02-15

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY'S HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR FY2015 IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,800,000.00 FOR THE HURRICANE GUSTAV SEVERE REPETITIVE LOSS AND REPETITIVE LOSS ELEVATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is a federal agency charged with overseeing emergency management services and is congressionally mandated through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to help address severe losses due to storm damage; and,

WHEREAS, FEMA has established the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to help address severe losses due to storm damage among other objectives; and,

WHEREAS, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program has allocated Federal Funds to the State of Louisiana to be directed toward home elevation that are classified as Severe Repetitive Loss and Repetitive Loss Properties; and,

WHEREAS, St. Bernard Parish is eligible to apply for this funding in the amount not to exceed \$2,800,000.00 with a 75% Federal/25% Local Match; and,

WHEREAS, if successful, an estimated \$100,000.00 would need to be budgeted to provide local matching funds, Staff Administrative Cost and other non-funded grant required costs; and,

WHEREAS, the property owners will be required to provide the 25% match per parcel, which shall not exceed \$37,500.00 plus any additional cost that may be associated with administering their project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby authorize the submission of a grant application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency's FY2015 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for
