

PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST

Pursuant to La. R.S. 44:1, *et seq.*, we request that any records related to invoices from or the payment of monies to Patrick Fanning and Edward F. Kohnke, IV, and Rachal D. Chance of Preis & Roy, for attorney's fees and expenses associated with representing St. Bernard Parish Government in litigation or claims related to *naegleria fowleri* be made available for inspection and copying.

Additionally, we request a list of the lawsuits pending against the Parish, which list categorizes the loss contingency estimates, as noted in Note 16 – Litigation, and which is a part of the 2016 Parish Audit.

According to La. R.S. 44:32, if there is a question as to whether the records requested are public records, then you are to notify Patrice and/or Nunzio Cusimano in writing within three days, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, of receipt of this request, of your determination and the reasons for same. "Such written notification shall contain a reference to the basis under which law the custodian has determined exempts a record, or any part thereof, from inspection, copying, or reproduction."
