President's Report **Council Meeting of Tuesday, July 2, 2019**

Good afternoon Council Members, Ladies and Gentlemen:

FISHING INDUSTRIES - This morning we hosted a press conference to discuss the effects of the recurring freshwater diversion from the Bonnet Carre spillway into the parish's estuary. We will make a full-court press with congressional leaders on both sides of the aisle and with officials running federal departments with jurisdiction over coastal, environmental, and commercial matters. Our Administration has compiled relevant information to present to the Congressional Delegation and the Secretary of Commerce about the impact on the environment and on St. Bernard's important fishing industries.
