AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 20, TRAFFIC; ARTICLE III, OPERATING REGULATIONS AND STREET DESIGNATIONS; DIVISION 2, SPEED; SECTION 20-72 SPEED LIMITS; AUTHORITY TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO SET; SPECIFIC LIMITS OF THE ST. BERNARD PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

ST. BERNARD PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The Parish Council hereby amends Chapter 20, Traffic; Article III, Operating Regulations and Street Designations; Division 2, Speed; Section 20-72 Speed Limits; authority to the Director of Public Works; specific limits as attached in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon authorizing signature by the Parish President. In the event of a presidential veto, this Ordinance shall become effective upon a two-thirds favorable vote of the total membership of the Council pursuant to Sections 2-11 and 2-13 of the St. Bernard Parish Home Rule Charter.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the St. Bernard Parish Council hereby expresses and declares that it would have adopted the remaining portion this Ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.



Exhibit "A"

Chapter 20 - Traffic
Article III - Operating Regulations and Street Designations
Division 2 - Speed

Section 20-72 Speed Limits; authority to the Director of Public Works to set; specific limits

- (a) Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, the Director of Public Works may decrease maximum speed limits at intersections and outside census-defined urban districts and he may increase limits within urban districts.
- (b) Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, the parish traffic engineer may determine the maximum speed limits on arterial streets.
- (c) Speed limits established pursuant to this section shall be applicable at all or such times as shall be indicated by official traffic-control devices.
- (d) Speed limit established; exceptions generally.

Except as otherwise provided for authorized emergency vehicles in section 20-77, it shall be unlawful for any person to run or operate any motor vehicle through or upon the streets of the parish at a greater speed than twenty (20) miles per hour, with the exceptions as stated in this section. When signs are posted indicating the speed limits as established in such exceptions, it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle in excess of such speed limits. The exceptions are as follows:

- (1) The speed limit established in Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of Louisiana or as posted by the Louisiana State Highway Department are hereby adopted as the speed limits on state highways running through the parish;
- (2) The speed limit on Patricia from Angela to Dr. Meraux Lane shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour. The speed limit on W. Genie from Village Square West to Packerham Drive shall be thirty (30) miles per hour. The speed limit on E. Genie from Paris Road (La. 47) to Ventura shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
- (3) The speed limit on Center from Benjamin to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
- (4) The speed limit on Mehle from Rocheblave to North Peters shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
- (5) The speed limit on Rowley from Patricia to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
- (6) The speed limit on Perrin from Benjamin to Norton shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;

- (7) The speed limit on Jean Lafitte Parkway from Hermitage to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
 - (8) The speed limit on Pakenham Avenue from West Judge Perez Drive (La. 39) to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (9) The speed limit on Village Square East/Old Hickory from Jamestown to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (10) The speed limit on W. Village Square from Genie to West Judge Perez Drive (La. 39) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (11) The speed limit on Pakenham Drive from Genie to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (12) The speed limit on Delille from W. Liberaux to West Judge Perez Drive (La. 39) shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
 - (13) The speed limit on Plaza from Genie to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
 - (14) The speed limit on Palmisano from Magistrate to St. Bernard Hwy. (La. 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (15) The speed limit on St. Avide from Randazzo to Volpe shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (16) The speed limit on Ventura from Florida to West Judge Perez Drive (La. 39) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (17) The speed limit on Bartolo from Florida to West Judge Perez Drive (La. 39) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour;
 - (18) The speed limit on Citrus Lane from La. Hwy. 46 to La. Hwy. 624 shall be thirty (30) miles per hour.
 - (19) The speed limit on Colonial Drive from Judge Perez Drive (LA 39) to St. Bernard Highway (LA 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour.
 - (20) The speed limit on Archbishop Phillip M. Hannan Boulevard from Judge Perez Drive (LA 39) to St. Bernard Highway (LA 46) shall be thirty (30) miles per hour.
 - (21) The speed limit on De Bouchel Boulevard from Judge Perez Drive (LA 39) to Florida Avenue shall be twenty (20) miles per hour.
- (e) The Director of Public Works, with the approval of the Parish Council by resolution, shall have the authority to determine the speed limit of any dedicated street that does not have sidewalks and is less than eight feet wide and less than a quarter of a mile long.
