Good evening Council Members, Ladies and Gentlemen:

Office of Homeland Security – The Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness began utilizing a new service to provide important, valuable community information when you need it, using the latest technology. The office will create and publish messages through a system called Nixle. Nixle will deliver this information to you instantly via text, email and web message. There are several simple ways to register:

1. Text your ZIPCODE to 888777 from your mobile phone
2. Go to the St. Bernard Homeland Security Webpage and sign up via “Nixle Emergency

Alerts Notifications can also be accessed online at Nixle's website at www.nixle.com. The service is secure, reliable and easy to use. You decide what information you want and whether you want it sent to your cell phone, email or simply over the web.

Water and Sewer – *the Department of Health and Human Services awarded a \$13 Million Dollar loan to St. Bernard Waterworks.* The loan is through the State's Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund, and will help the water system improve its drinking water quality. The following projects will be accomplished as a result of the loan:

- Replacement of aging and deteriorating cast iron water lines in the distribution system.
- Installation of a 20-inch diameter PVC waterline extension along Hwy. 46 in St. Bernard to address low pressure and improve fire protection.
- Adding fire hydrants, valves, service lines, meters and fittings along the length of the new and replaced water lines.
