BERNARD PARISH GOVERNMENT COMPLEX, 8201 WEST JUDGE PEREZ DRIVE, CHALMETTE, LOUISIANA ON TUESDAY, APRIL 3, 2018 AT SEVEN O'CLOCK P.M.

On motion of Mr. McCloskey, seconded by Mr. Lewis, it was moved to **adopt** the following resolution:

RESOLUTION SBPC #1821-04-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO APPROVE NEW CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A 50-YARD SHOOTING RANGE. THE PETITIONED PROPERTY IS MANAGED BY ST. BERNARD PARISH SHERIFF OFFICE AND EXEMPT FROM ZONING CODE PER THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 5-21. – EXEMPTION OF GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS AND LAND AND SCHOOLS WITH ENROLLMENT OF 500 OR MORE STUDENTS. THE PROPERTY IS DESIGNATED AS LOTS 1 THRU 26 OF SQUARES 545, 546, 547, AND 548 OF VERSAILLES SUBDIVISION LOCATED IN T12S-R12E SECTIONS 25 & 48.

WHEREAS, a need exists to construct a shooting range as a part of the overall facility operations and individual law enforcement training requirements supporting the St. Bernard Parish Sheriff Office; and

WHEREAS, the request is located in an existing and isolated I-2 (Heavy Industrial) zoning district, anticipated to have minimal impact to adjacent and surrounding land uses; and

WHEREAS, the facility request promotes and is consistent with the overall health, safety and welfare needs supporting the public-at-large.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the St. Bernard Parish Council, does hereby approve the request subject to the requirements of Section 5-21 – Exemption of government buildings and lands and schools with enrollment of 500 or more students.
