Council Meeting of Tuesday, November 6, 2018

Good evening Council Members, Ladies and Gentlemen:

Trunk or Treat – Hundreds attended the 3rd Annual Trunk or Treat on **Friday, October 26th** in Torres Park. We want to thank all of the volunteers for their hard work and the sponsors for donating vehicles and candy for the event.

Clean Fuel Summit – Councilman Howard Luna and Dale Thayer of our Community Development Office recently participated in the Clean Fuel Summit, where valuable information on the state's clean transportation efforts and alternative vehicle and infrastructure funding opportunities. We are currently researching clean fuel options and public funding for the parish's fleet vehicles.
