President's Report **Council Meeting of Tuesday, December 18, 2018**

Good afternoon Council Members, Ladies and Gentlemen:

Coastal – CWPPRA Technical Committee approved Phase 1 funding for the East Delacroix Marsh creation and Terracing Project. The \$39 Million Dollar Project will create over 350 acres of marsh and several miles of terracing on the east side of Delacroix. We are fortunate to have gotten another large-scale coastal restoration project funded. The Delacroix project is particularly important because of its potential to mitigate storm surge and increase the resilience of our historic fishing communities outside of the levee system.

Violet Canal Maintenance Dredging – 8,000 cubic yards of material has been dredged from the Violet Canal between St. Bernard Highway and the Violet Canal Bridge. This was a joint effort between Parish Government and Coastal Protection Restoration Authority. The project was completed in early December.

Donuts with Santa - The Leisure Department hosted Donuts with Santa this past Saturday with over 300 people in attendance. Each child received a photo with Santa, two donuts and a toy. A special thank you goes to Gerald's Donuts, Mc Donald's of St. Bernard and Raising Canes for providing breakfast and Billy Vaughn and participants of the USSSA Tournament for donating toys for the event.

Recreation – The Recreation Department has seen an increase in registration for this year's Basketball Season. The total number of children participating this year is 613 compared to 551 last year. The season runs through the end of January.

Code Enforcement – The Code Enforcement Department is working to address code violations. To date the department has issued 20 demolition orders, 3 pool demolitions and imposed over \$60,000 in code violation fines in 2018
